

Hamilton Farmers Market Co-op Vetting Process

The Hamilton Farmers Market contains a curated collection of local farmers, skilled artisans, and a handful of non-profits. Acceptance into the HFMC shall be determined yearly through a jury process of the applicant's products. All agricultural products must originate in Ravalli County and produce grown from non-GMO seed. Non-agricultural products must be of high quality, be original and made in Ravalli County.

Criteria

- Vendors must reside in Ravalli County, and be prepared to show proof of residency upon request.
- Reselling of mass-produced goods is not allowed.
- Multi-Level Marketing and/or Franchise companies are not permitted.
- No vendors, non-profits, or community groups may reserve space if the purpose of the booth includes religious or political activity, defined as expressing religious views; or advocating any political party, candidate, or law.
- All products which display lewd or sexual content are banned. Prospective vendors invited to participate in the market will be asked to remove the offending items, once, in writing. If those items are not removed, immediate and permanent suspension will follow.
- Artisan's work must be original.

* Failure to follow the the guidelines may result in temporary or permanent suspension, no refunds will be given if applicant is found to be performing outside the the above criteria.
